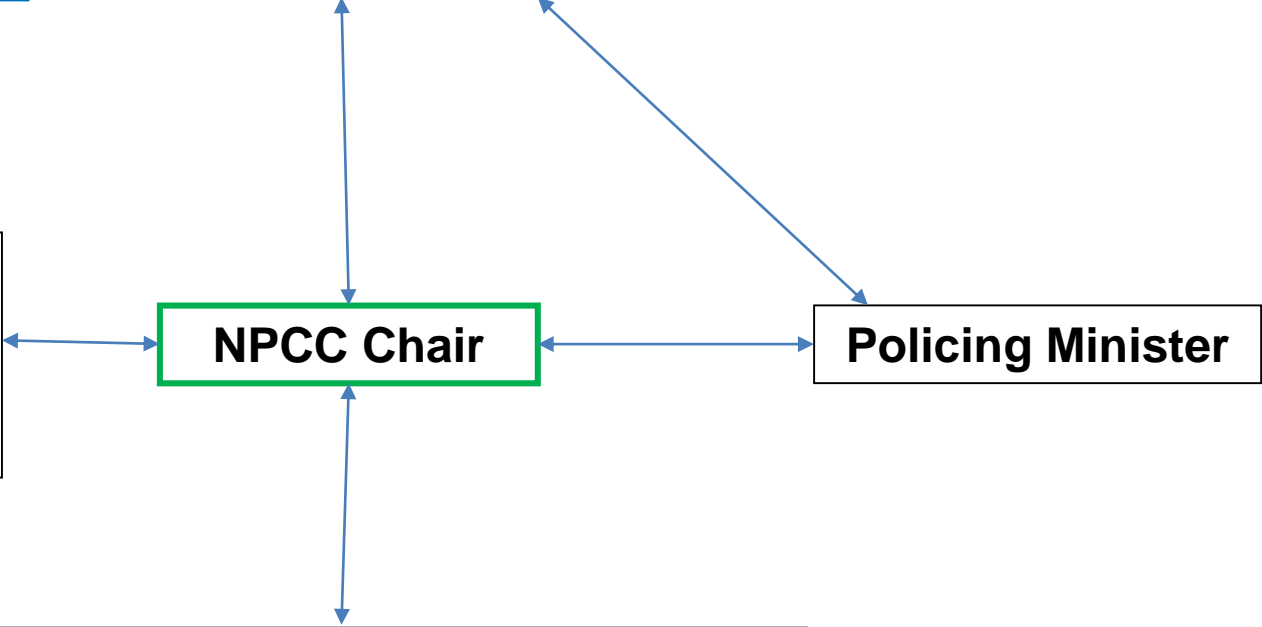

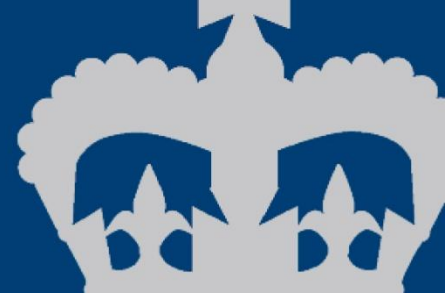

Policing and Crime Bill 2016

- **Emergency Services Collaboration**
 - Existing Collaboration Commitment and proven drive
 - Why Collaborate further?
 - Legal requirement
 - Opportunities to provide an enhanced service to the public
 - Provide greater value for money to the public
 - Improved Interoperability



• **What are we currently doing?**

- Emergency Services Collaboration Working Group
 - Enable sharing of experience and evidence about ‘what works’
- Joint Strategic group to establish principles to support greater collaboration
 - Develop a principles led approach to collaboration.
- Joint presentations to the Chief Constables Council and the FRS Council
 - Enable debate and discussion
 - Demonstrate to the Home Office how we are and can continue to work together
